Our staff are highly trained to recognise and respond to the impact of early trauma, attachment difficulties, and neurodiversity, ensuring every pupil is met with compassion and a tailored approach.

Our bespoke virtual model supports pupils in remaining with dedicated teachers and class throughout the day, minimising transitions and reducing anxiety. Lessons are delivered using secondary level content but adapted to each child's developmental stages and individual needs. We also offer a dedicated nurture class, supported by tools such as the Boxall Profile, for pupils requiring more intensive therapeutic input.
